Initially supported by three of Houston's leading philanthropies including Arnold Ventures, The Houston Endowment, and the Kinder Foundation, we are building a team to support our efforts in sustainability and revenue growth.

At Houston Landing, we are expanding our development team to include an Assistant Director of Development - Major Gifts. The Assistant Director of Development will report directly to the Chief Development Officer, as a frontline fundraiser, and will materially contribute to achieving fundraising goals across the organization, through institutional funding. The salary range for this position is \$70,000 - \$85,000.

What you'll do

- Create a development plan for strategic moves management of major gift donors.
- Build and manage a mixed portfolio of 75-100 donors giving between \$5,000 \$50,000 to include identification, prospecting, cultivation, solicitation, and stewardship.
- Work closely with the Chief Development Officer to drive the strategic growth of major gift revenue.
- Gather and record information about prospects and donors utilizing the Landing's donor management system (Raiser's Edge NXT).
- Conduct donor communication including phone calls, virtual as well as in-person visits monthly to secure over \$150,000 in gifts annually.
- Contribute to meeting annual revenue goals and be accountable for individual and team KPIs
- Build and maintain effective relationships cross departmentally while encouraging a culture of philanthropy amongst other team members.
